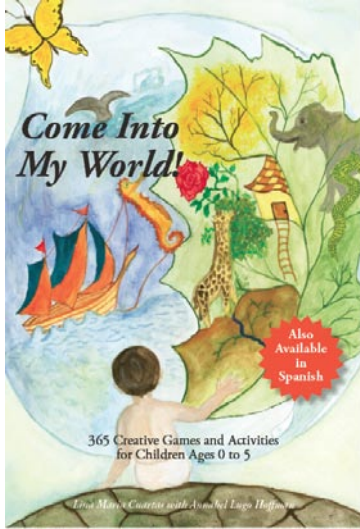


Children's Activity Books Offer Parents Fun and Inexpensive Project Ideas 365 Days a Year
